DT - <u>Melting lava brownie</u> <u>volcanoes</u>

Ingredients: Brownie mix, red icing, chocolate, syrup, mini muffin pan.

Directions: Prepare the brownie mix as directed on the package. Grease the cups in a mini-muffin pan or use mini-cupcake cases. Fill the cups in the pan 3/4 of the way full with brownie mix. Cook as directed on the package. Let the brownies cool in the pan. Once cooled remove them and place them on a plate upside down. Top with red icing and drizzled chocolate syrup.
