Use whatever materials you have available at home and bring your masterpiece into school.</p> 	<p><b>DT - <u>Melting lava brownie volcanoes</u></b></p> <p><b>Ingredients:</b> Brownie mix, red icing, chocolate, syrup, mini muffin pan. <b>Directions:</b> Prepare the brownie mix as directed on the package. Grease the cups in a mini-muffin pan or use mini-cupcake cases. Fill the cups in the pan 3/4 of the way full with brownie mix. Cook as directed on the package. Let the brownies cool in the pan. Once cooled remove them and place them on a plate upside down.
