HOT CHOCOLATE CLUB

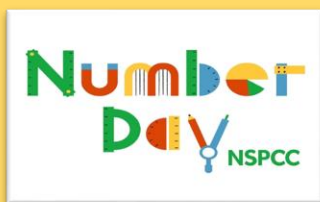

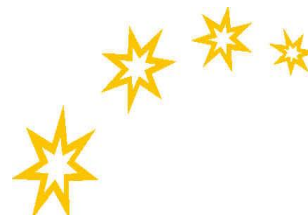
