The Creative Workshop in Par who have provided us with some extremely delicious butterfly buns which have been enjoyed by members of the year 6 after-school maths club, today.


The Creative Workshop is a day care facility for adults with learning and physical disabilities and is of real benefit to our community! Their baking skills are also very much appreciated by the community!
