"Unfortunately, Cornwall Outdoors who run Porthpean Outdoor Centre, have now informed us that they need to **cancel all residential camps this summer**. As part of the funding cuts across different aspects of Cornwall Council, the future of the centre is uncertain. The impact of this is that they have been unable to take on sufficient staff to run their residential stays and unfortunately, this affects our camp which was planned for 23rd to 25th May.

We realise that this will be a huge disappointment for the children who were planning on attending so we are currently putting together a plan for some exciting daytime activities, which we hope we can share with you soon after Easter. These will hopefully present more opportunities for more children including those who had not signed up to attend the camp, for any reason."

For those parents of children who were planning to attend the camp, we will process refunds of any payments you have made already, at the start of next term.
